EVIDENCE OF MY CLOSE READING OF TEXT	COMMENTS
<p>5-4-Highly Effective: - My annotations clearly connect to the purpose for reading. Purpose: _____ -Highly effective use of annotations would mean that I have used my important annotations as evidence and support for my written and spoken analysis.</p>	
<p>3-Effective: -My annotations are mostly connected to the purpose for reading. (The evidence for this is that I make note of things in the text with questions, predictions and conclusions that are often important for being able to answer the purpose setting question, though at times my reasons for making note of things may not be completely evident.) -Effective use of annotations would mean that it is evident how my annotations are referenced in my response, but that at times these references do not clearly help to support the claims in my written and spoken analysis. (Further evidence of this exists in the degree to which my annotations help me to support my extended response)</p>	
<p>2-Somewhat Effective: -There is evidence that my annotations are connected to the purpose for reading, but it is infrequent enough that a clear purpose for reading is not evident. (The evidence for this is that I make note of many things the text by asking questions, and restating information, but I don't make important conclusions about the text.) -Somewhat effective use of annotations would mean that it is clear that I am using my annotations to support my claims but, quite often, it is unclear how or if these references support my claims. (Further evidence exists in the limited way in which my annotations serve to support my extended response..)</p>	
<p>1-Ineffective: 0There is little or no evidence that my annotations connect to my purpose for reading. (The evidence of this is that I may have very few annotations or my annotations show few or no conclusions and little or no connection to the purpose for reading.) -It is not evident, or there is very little evidence, of how my annotations help me to support my extended response.</p>
